



## Lodi Grapes

Lodi is on the edge of the Sacramento Delta central valley region of California. Just between Sacramento and Stockton on the way to the bay area.

### Varietal Reds

- Cabernet Sauvignon**- The "King of Red Wine". Rich in color, intensely flavored, tannic wine with hints of mint, blackberry, and black current with spicy vanilla aromas.
- Merlot**- Classic grape of Bordeaux. Has soft tannins, low acid and matures quickly. Drinks well when young.
- Syrah**- Also known as "Shiraz" in Australia, this grape will produce a dark, rich, full-bodied, wine with a chocolate aroma
- Zinfandel**- Yields an excellent red wine with dark color, characteristic spicy flavor and strong berry flavors that will stand up to extended oak aging.
- Sangiovese**- The principle grape of Chianti will produce a dark, powerful, medium bodied wine with flavors of cherry and plum.
- Pinot Noir**- Used in the famous Burgundy wines of France. It is considered to be one of the richest and most velvety wines in the world.
- Petite Syrah**- Produces a dark, dry, full-bodied, and tannic red with intense berry flavor. Currently getting a boost in popularity due to some California winemakers

### Varietal Whites

- Sauvignon Blanc**- Extremely versatile grape, which can be vinified in a number of styles. Produces a wine with a citrus, gooseberry flavor and a herbaceous aroma.
- Chardonnay**- One of the world's great wine grapes. Produces wines that can be described as buttery, creamy, nutty and smoky.
- Pinot Grigio/Pinto Gris**. Italian style white wine. Produces a crisp, light, dry wine.
- Riesling**- The most noble and expressive of white wine varieties. Riesling is "The Great White" of German wines and can be produced in both dry or *Trocken* and slightly sweet or *Auslese* styles.
- Fume Blanc** - Barrel fermented Sauvignon Blanc; Robert Mondavi originated this style.
- Bordeaux Blanc**- Sauvignon Blanc & Semillon. Charming easy drinking white Bordeaux revealing a wonderful selection of peach and citrus fruits. Mouth watering acidity creates a crisp and fresh finish making it ideal served with seafood.
- Sauvignon Blanc / Viognier**- A Blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Viognier

- Cabernet/Merlot**- Cabernet, Merlot. Typical Bordeaux Style Wine
- Merlot/Cabernet**- Merlot, Cabernet. This blend has been continually great!
- Cabernet/Zinfandel**-Cabernet, Zinfandel.
- Chateaufeuf Du Pape**- Grenache/Syrah/Merlot/Carignane. Great Southern Rhone style wine.
- Tres Ce'Pages**- Cabernet, Merlot, Cabernet Franc. A combination of three world famous grapes.
- Super Tuscan**-Sangiovese, Cabernet,Merlot. This wine seems to be "built for food". This wine possesses a good bit of acidity, the kind of acidity that clears the palate and makes you want to take another bite!
- Barolo**- The "big" black-red wine of Italy's Piedmont Region.Nebbiolo and Barbera. The blending of these grapes (which have opposite characteristics) produces a wine, which has fine taste balance but is still bold and powerful.
- "The Family Recipe"**- Frank's Barbera Blend. A combination of Barbera and Petite Syrah, this wine will be the crowd-pleaser at any dinner table!
- "Northern-Cali. Field Blend"** -Carignane, Zinfandel, Petite Sirah. A real "Winemakers Wine". Great for drinking young, and also quite age-worthy. Filled with all that we love about red wine: Red-fruit character, bit peppery, good tannins, slightly higher alcohol. Everybody LOVES The Northern-Cali. Blend!
