The Oak Knoll District (Napa Valley) one of the newest AVA'S (Awarded in April 2004). This 8300-acre viticulture area (with 3500 acres under vine) is located toward the southern end of Napa Valley. It is home to some famous wineries, i.e.: William Hill, Andretti Winery, Trefethan Vineyards, and Hagafin Cellars to name a few.

Varietal Reds

Cabernet Sauvignon- The "King of Red Wine". Rich in color, intensely flavored, tannic wine with hints of mint, blackberry, and black current with spicy vanilla aromas.

Merlot- Classic grape of Bordeaux. Has soft tannins, low acid and matures quickly.
